

## CENTERVILLE CHURCH OF CHRIST MORRISON / NICKS SCHOLARSHIP

### I. PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Centerville Church of Christ Morrison/ Nicks Scholarship is to help provide those who are interested in furthering their education beyond the High School level at an accredited institution of learning with that opportunity under the provision and stipulations contained in this application.

In providing this opportunity, it is hoped that scholarship recipients will be lifetime workers for the Lord in their chosen vocation and church work wherever life takes them.

### II. PROVISIONS AND STIPULATIONS

*Provided* applicant is a member of the Centerville Church of Christ or a dependent child of a member of the Centerville Church of Christ. In exceptional cases the foregoing requirement may be waived by the Scholarship Committee provided the applicant or the applicant's parents qualify with membership in another congregation of the Church of Christ.

*Provided* applicant shows continued active participation and attendance in the Centerville Church and its work.

*Provided* applicant is a high school senior or graduate, and meets the requirements for entrance into the chosen institution of learning, or is eligible for continuing enrollment in the institution in which presently enrolled or transferring into.

*Provided* applicant's records show adequate academic achievement and participation in high school and /or at an institution providing education/training beyond the High School level.

*Provided* applicant demonstrates strong motivation for continued higher education.

### III. IT IS FURTHER PROVIDED THAT:

*Whereas* the Centerville Church of Christ Scholarship Fund was initially made possible by the last will and Testament of Dr. Bobby Morrison, former member and church treasurer of the Centerville Church of Christ and a local dentist, and Ms. Emma Nicks, a member of the Centerville Church of Christ and longtime teacher in the Hickman County School System.

*The Scholarship Committee will give priority consideration* to applicants attending a Church of Christ Institution as well as the financial need based on the cost of the individual private and state institutions.

### IV. GENERAL INFORMATION

*Scholarships* shall be granted for a one year period, normally the institution's academic year, and must be reapplied for each year.

*Selection* of scholarship recipients is accomplished by the Scholarship Committee based on the merits of the application and with final approval of the elders of the Centerville Church of Christ.

*Payment* of scholarship grants will be made directly to institution of learning on a bi-annual basis unless otherwise arranged with the Centerville Church of Christ Bookkeeper.

**V. APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIP:**

Obtain a copy of the Scholarship Application from the office of the Centerville Church of Christ. Only one copy is needed, but must be accompanied by the following supporting papers;

1. Official transcript of High School record or latest transcript/grade report from attendee's institution of learning.
2. Letter(s) of recommendation from principal, counselor, or teacher. This is applicable to initial applicants only.
3. A letter from the applicant with specific facts concerning the desire for continued education/training.
4. Other supporting documents are optional.
