"From Where I Sit"



Revelation 2:10

There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one faith, one baptism, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all" (Ephesians 4:4-6).

In the Bible we read about several baptisms, the baptism of John (Mark 1:4-5), the baptism of the Holy Spirit (Matthew 3:11), the baptism of fire (Matthew 3:11-12), and the baptism commanded by Christ in the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20). However, when the apostle Paul wrote to the Ephesians, he stated that there is only "one baptism." The people to whom this letter was written could certainly identify it. According to Acts 19:5, "they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus." The people who became Christians in Ephesus were baptized with the baptism commanded by Christ in the Great Commission. This is the "one baptism" mentioned in Ephesians 4:5.

This "one baptism" has certain prerequisites. It is to be preceded by belief (Mark 16:16), by repentance (Acts 2:38), and a confession of Jesus Christ as God's son (Romans 10:10). Based on these prerequisites, we conclude that the Lord does not approve of the many other forms and false teachings of baptism that many try to push today. There is "one baptism". One! Scripture cannot be any clearer than that.

The Bible teaches a particular way the "one baptism" is to be administered. It is in water (Acts 8:38), and it is a burial (Colossians 2:12). Scriptural baptism is "immersion." How can the sprinkling or pouring of water be considered a burial? It cannot! The Bible says that Philip and the eunuch went down into the water.

The Bible clearly teaches that the "one baptism" is for the remission, forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38), it is at that point at which one's sins are washed away (Acts 22:16), and it is necessary for one's salvation. Unfortunately, there are many religious groups that reject these teachings. I recently read an article that said, "We in the _____ church believe that no one is a subject for scriptural baptism until they are already saved." In all love and kindness, people who have complied with this doctrine need to follow the teachings and the example of the men in Ephesus and be "baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus." Understand that salvation comes after one is immersed. Following the Bible and the Bible only about the "one baptism" of Ephesians 4:5.

Submitting to the "one baptism" is the ONLY way to get into Christ (Roman 6:3-7; Galatians 3:26-29) as well as the one body (1 Corinthians 12:13). Have you obeyed the scriptural command to be baptized (immersed) for the forgiveness of your sins? All we ask is that one follow the direct commands of what the Bible teaches on the subject of "one baptism", nothing more, nothing less!


