

COVID-19 POLICY FOR 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

EXPOSURE AT DAY SCHOOL:

We will notify parents of the children who have been exposed to a positive Covid case at Day School as determined by any of the following: a home test, rapid test, or Covid test from a public or private health clinic.

The child will be dismissed from Day School for three days, with the day of exposure being day 0. On day four, they may return IF THEY ARE SYMPTOM FREE. Please refer to our current Health Policy (found in the Parent Handbook) to determine when children should not attend school with any sickness.

As per the Enrollment Agreement signed during Fall registration, the first three consecutive days missed for weather, pandemic, etc., are not subject to any discounts or credits for tuition.

If your child is exposed a second time at Day School, and must be dismissed again for three days, tuition will be discounted by 50% for the three days. This will hold your child's spot on the roster.

If your child is exposed at Day School for a third time, there will be no charge for those first three days they are dismissed, and their spot will still be secure.

We have no desire to keep healthy children from attending school any longer than is necessary. We understand that you need care and education for your child, and for this reason we will continue to review our policy as needed to make sure it is achieving the desired results for students, families, and staff.

Any other days a student is absent from class for sickness, OR it is the parent(s) choice to extend the period beyond the three days that their (symptom free) child does not attend after exposure, will be charged at the full tuition rate.

OUTSIDE EXPOSURE:

If your child is a household contact (there is a positive case of Covid within the home), or exposure to Covid has occurred outside of Day School, the Health Department guidance **MUST BE FOLLOWED**, and there is no credits or discounts given for any missed days.

We depend on our parents to keep us informed as to the health status of your child. To be successful in managing our Center, we must be proactive in dealing with Covid and other illnesses. Please adhere to the guidelines already in place as outlined in our current Health Policy and found in your Parent Handbook. If for some reason you do not have a copy, please request a copy immediately.

Your child and their good health, as well as our families and staff, is our main focus during these challenging times. Thank you for choosing us to love and care for your child/children.
