

That makes it the responsibility of every Christian, and every Christian should feel like Paul did, who said "woe is unto me if I preach not the gospel!" (1 Corinthians 9:16).

The Lord has need for every Christian to show and to share the light of Christ to all. And while the task seems hard, we can know that we are not working alone, for He promised, "Lo, I am with you always" (Matthew 26:20).
