

The Ministry Of Reconciliation

Sunday, as we come to the third installment of our four-part series, 'The Kingdom Of God In My Life', we will give focus to what Paul calls 'the ministry of reconciliation.' In his second letter to the Corinthian church, Paul lays out our calling to be reconciled to God and to each other. It is a marvelous and powerful challenge.

We will read and listen and study together and be encouraged about who we are, the promise that we have in Jesus and the power we have been given to be people and to be a church of reconciliation. I look forward to sharing with you.


